



DECISION N° **18250230** /MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC of **123 MAI 2025**  
To launch the competitive entrance examination into the 1<sup>st</sup> year of the Engineering Sciences course at the National Higher Polytechnic School of Douala (NHPSD) of the University of Douala, and to specify the number of places available for the academic year 2025/2026.

Mindful of decree N°93/032 of 19 January 1993 to fix the financial regime applicable to universities;  
Mindful of decree N°2012/433 of 01 October 2012 to organize the ministry of Higher Education;  
Mindful of decree N°2017/318 of 27 June 2017 to appoint Rectors and vice-chancellors of certain state Universities;  
Mindful of decree N°2020/303 of 08 June 2020 to appoint officials in some state universities;  
Mindful of decree N° 2017/0891/PM of 12 March 2013 to appoint officials at the ministry of higher education;  
Mindful of decree N° 202/272 of 11 may 2020 to fix the transformation of the Faculty of Industrial Engineering into the National Higher Polytechnic School of Douala;  
Mindful of Decision n°18250145/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC du 07 April 2025 to organize the calendar of competitive entrance examinations into Faculties, Schools and institutions of Cameroon state Universities for 2025/2026 academic year;

**DECIDES:**

**Article 1:(1)** A direct competitive entrance examination for the recruitment of **one hundred (100)** students into the first year of engineering sciences-course of the National Higher Polytechnic School of the University of Douala has been launched for the 2025/2026 academic year, in the centers of **BAMENDA, BANDJOUN, BERTOUA, BUEA, EBOLOWA, DOUALA, GAROUA, MAROUA, NGAOUNDERE and YAOUNDE.**

Students admitted into the engineering sciences course would have to choose at the end of their second year of training between the different fields of study below for the continuation of their training: **Electronics; Electrical Engineering; Automation and Telecommunication; Mechanics**

and Materials; Geophysics, Water and Environment; Energy; Data Science and Artificial Intelligence; Industrial Chemistry and Industrial Bioprocesses.

(2) The entrance examination consists of two written papers; Mathematics and Physics of three (03) hours duration each and of equal importance.

**Article 2:** The competitive entrance examination is open to:

- Students preparing Baccalaureate of series C, D, E, F, IT, and BT;
- Students from Upper Sixth science offering at least two of the following subjects: Pure Mathematics, Physics and Further Mathematics, and GCE-O/L in at least four (04) subjects (excluding religious knowledge)
- Holders of Baccalaureate in the above mentioned series or of the GCE-A/L
- Holders of all certificates equivalent to the baccalaureate or GCE-AL recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education.

**Article 3:**(1) The syllabus for the entrance examination is based on the “Lower” and “Upper” Sixth programs of both general and technical Education for series C, D, E and F, BT of the French sub-system and GCE-AL science for the English sub-system.

(2) There will be no oral examination.

**Article 4:** Students on awaiting results will be declared successful in the written entrance examination into the NHPSD, upon presentation of the original certificate obtained in 2025, or presentation of success testimonial at the time of registration fixed by the NHPSD.

**Article 5:** Registration shall be done online through the school website at: [www.enspd-udo.cm](http://www.enspd-udo.cm)

candidate's file shall include the following documents:

- 1- An individual registration form to be downloaded from the website [www.enspd-udo.cm](http://www.enspd-udo.cm), duly completed and stamped for 1500frs CFA by the candidate;
- 2- A certified photocopy of birth certificate not older than three months, signed by a competent authority.
- 3- A certified photocopy of the Baccalaureate or GCE-A/L in science subjects or an equivalent diploma or a certificate of success in one of these diplomas, if applicable, signed by a competent administrative authority.
- 4- A certified photocopy of transcripts of the “Probatoire” or GCE O/L for candidates on awaiting results, Baccalaureate or GCE A/L as appropriate, signed by a competent administrative authority.
- 5- A medical certificate duly drawn up and issued by a state medical practitioner;
- 6- An A4 envelope bearing a 1000 francs CFA postal stamp with candidate's address on it.

**Article 6:** The registration fees for the entrance examination is **Twenty Thousand (20 000) Francs CFA** payable at the **UBA bank Account n° 0 100 500 000 287** of the National Higher Polytechnic School of Douala (NHPSD) of the University of Douala or through the services of **Express Union to the same account in towns where UBA is not present**; (bank receipt should be included in candidates' file). The registration fees are not reimbursable. It is destined to cover charges generated as the result of the organisation of the entrance examination. **Any other means of payment is not accepted.**

**Article 7:** All complete application files must be deposited at the admissions office of the National Higher Polytechnic School of Douala (NHPSD) of the University of Douala or at the Regional Delegations of the Ministry of Secondary Education latest **Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> July 2025 at 3:30 pm.**

**Article 8:** Only candidates who have submitted complete application files will be authorised to sit for the examination. They are therefore requested to come along with their National Identity Card and the examination registration receipt (to be downloaded) which must be presented to the authorities before entering the examination hall.

**Article 9:** The candidates for the competitive entrance examination into the first year must not be more than twenty-nine (29) years old by January 1<sup>st</sup> 2025.

**Article 10:** The written examination will take place on **Sunday, the 27<sup>th</sup> July 2025, at 8 am** in the centres indicated above.

**Article 11:** -The Rector of the University of Douala, the Director of University Accreditations and Quality, and the Director of the National Higher Polytechnic School of Douala (NHPSD) are, each in their capacity, responsible for the implementation of this decision which shall be registered and published in French and English wherever need may arise.
