DECISION N° _____/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC of _____
To launch the competitive entrance examination into the **Third year** of the **Special –regime training of the Engineering course** at the National Higher Polytechnic School of Douala (NHPSD), of the University of Douala, and to specify the number of places available for the academic year 2025/2026.

THE MINISTER OF STATE, MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION:

- Mindful of the constitution;
- Mindful of law N° 2023/007 of 25 July 2023 on the orientation of Higher Education in Cameroon;
- Mindful of decree N°2011/408 of 09 December 2011 to organize the government;
- Mindful of decree N°2011/410 of 09 December 2011 to appoint members of government;
- Mindful of decree N°93/026 of 19 January 1993 creating Universities;
- Mindful of decree N°2005/342 of 10 September 2025 to define provisions common to Universities, modified and completed by the decree N°93/027;
- Mindful of decree N°93/030 of 19 January 1993 to fix the administrative and academic organization of the University of Douala;
- Mindful of decree N°93/032 of 19 January 1993 to fix the financial regime applicable to universities;
- Mindful of decree N°2012/433 of 01 October 2012 to organize the ministry of Higher Education;
- Mindful of decree N°2017/318 of 27 June 2017 to appoint Rectors and vice-chancellors of certain state Universities;
- Mindful of decree N°2020/303 of 08 June 2020 to appoint officials in some state universities;
- Mindful of decree N° 2017/0891/PM of 12 March 2013 to appoint officials at the ministry of higher education;
- Mindful of decree N° 202/272 of 11 may 2020 to fix the transformation of the Faculty of Industrial Engineering into the National Higher Polytechnic School of Douala;
- Mindful of Decision n°18250145/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC du 07 April 2025 to organize the calendar of competitive entrance examinations into Faculties, Schools and institutions of Cameroon state Universities for 2025/2026 academic year;

DECIDES:

Article 1: The launching of a competitive entrance examination at the Douala unique center of the National Higher Polytechnic School of the University of Douala, the recruitment of **four hundred and fifty (450) students** for the 2025/2026 academic year according to the different specialities as follows:

Article 2: The competitive entrance is open to:

- Candidates who are holders of Scientific Degree; an Engineer Diploma of works; Degree in Technology, a professional degree in the specialty, an HND in the specialty, a scientific university diploma in technology(DUT), a scientific university diploma of general studies(DEUG) or any other equivalent diploma recognized by the Ministry of Higher Education.
- Candidates on awaiting results in 2024/2025 for the mentioned above certificates.

Article 3: (1) The syllabus for the examinations shall be the same as those for the classes leading up to the above mentioned qualifying diplomas. The written examination consists of a written paper depending on the candidate's specialty and shall last for three hours.

(2) There will be no oral exams.

Article 4: -candidate's application files shall include the following documents:

- 1- An individual registration form to be downloaded from the website www.enspd-udo.cm, duly completed and stamped at 1500frs CFA by the candidate;
- 2- A certified photocopy of birth certificate not older than three months, signed by a competent authority;
- 3- A certified photocopy of the required diploma for the examination or a certificate of success for the diploma, if applicable signed by a competent administrative authority of the issuing university;
- 4- Certified photocopies of level one, two and three transcripts signed by a competent administrative authority of the issuing university;
- 5- certified photocopies of "Probatoire" or GCE O/L and GCE A/L or "Baccalauréat" certificate or slip as the case may be, signed by a competent administrative authority;
- 6- A medical certificate duly established and issued by a state medical practitioner testifying that the candidate is fit for higher education;
- 7- An A4 format self-addressed envelope bearing a 1000 francs CFA postal stamp with candidate's address on it.

Article 5: The registration fees for the entrance examination is Twenty-Five Thousand (25 000) Francs CFA payable at the UBA bank Account n° 0 100 500 000 287 of the University of Douala or through the services of Express Union to the same account in towns where UBA is not present;

against a bank receipt which is obligatory to be included in candidate's file. **The registration fee is not reimbursable.** It is destined to cover charges generated as the result of the organisation of the entrance examination.

Any other means of payment is unacceptable.

Article 6: All complete application files must be deposited at the admissions office of the National Higher Polytechnic School of Douala (NHPSD) campus 3 of the University of Douala latest Thursday 25th September 2025 at 3:30 pm.

Article 7: Only candidates who have submitted complete application files will be authorised to sit for the examination. They are therefore requested to come along with their National Identity Card and the examination registration receipt (to be downloaded) which must be presented to the authorities before entering the examination hall.

Article 8: The candidates for the competitive entrance examination into the third year must not be older than thirty-two (32) years as on January 1st 2025.

Article 9: The written examination will take place on Sunday the 28th September 2025, at 8 am in the unique center of Douala.

Article 10: The Rector of the University of Douala, the Director of University Accreditations and Quality, and the Director of the National Higher Polytechnic School (NHPSD), are each in their capacity, responsible for the implementation of this decision which shall be registered and published in French and English wherever need arises.
