To launch the competitive entrance examination into the 1st year of the **Engineering Sciences course** at the National Higher Polytechnic School of Douala (NHPSD) of the University of Douala, and to specify the number of places available for the academic year 2024/2025.

- Mindful of Decree N°93/027 of 19 January 1993 to define provisions common to Universities, modified and completed by the decree N°2005/342 of 10 September 2005;
- Mindful of decree N°93/030 of 19 January 1993 to fix the administrative and academic organization of the University of Douala;
- Mindful of decree N°93/032 of 19 January 1993 to fix the financial regime applicable to universities;
- Mindful of decree N°2012/433 of 01 October 2012 to organize the ministry of Higher Education;
- Mindful of decree N°2015/398 of 27 august 2019 to appoint the Universities vice chancellor and Rectors;
- Mindful of decree N°2020/303 of 08 June 2020 to appoint officials in some state universities;
- Mindful of decree N° 2015/398 of 15 September 2015 to appoint officials at the ministry of higher education
- Mindful of decree N° 202/272 of 11 may 2020 to fix the transformation of the Faculty of Industrial Engineering into the National Higher School of Polytechnic of Douala;
- Mindful of Decisionn°18240028/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC of 14 February 2024 to organize the calendar of competitive entrance examinations into Faculties, Schools and institutions of Cameroon state Universities for 2024/2025academic year.

DECIDES

Article 1: (1) The public is here by informed that a competitive entrance examination for the recruitment of **eighty (80) students** into the **first year of engineering sciences course** of the National Higher Polytechnic School of Douala (NHPSD) of the University of Douala has been launched for the 2024/2025 academic year, in the centers of **BAMENDA, BANDJOUN, BERTOUA, BUEA, EBOLOWA, DOUALA, GAROUA, MAROUA, NGAOUNDERE and YAOUNDE.**

Students admitted into the engineering sciences course would have to choose at the end of their second year of training between the different fields of study below for the continuation of their training: **Electronics; Electrical Engineering; Automation and Telecommunication; Mechanics and Materials; Geophysics, Water and Environment; Energy; Data Science and Artificial Intelligence ; Industrial Chemistry and Industrial Bioprocesses.**

Students are not allowed to change field of study during training.

(2) The written examination consists of two papers, Mathematics and Physics of three (03) hours duration each and of equal importance.

Article 2: The competitive entrance examination is open to:

- Students preparing Baccalaureate of series C, D, E, IT, F and BT;
- Students from Upper Sixth science offering at least two of the following subjects: Pure Mathematics, Physics and Further Mathematics, and GCE-O/L in at least four (04) subjects (excluding religious knowledge)
- Holders of Baccalaureate in the above mentioned series or of the GCE-A/L
- Holders of all certificates equivalent to the baccalaureate or GCE-AL recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education.

Article 3: (1) The syllabus for the entrance examination shall be based on the “Lower” and “Upper” Sixth programs of both general and technical Education in the country for both series C, D, E and F, BT and GCE-AL.

(2) **There will be no oral examination.**

Article 4: Students on awaiting results will be declared successful in the written entrance examination into the NHPSD, upon presentation of the original certificate obtained in 2024, or presentation of success testimonial at the time of registration.

Article 5: Registration shall be done online through the school website at: www.enspd-udo.cm

- Candidate's files shall include the following documents:

- 1- An individual registration form to be completed online at www.enspd-udo.cm. The completed form shall be printed bearing a fiscal stamp of 1500 francs CFA and signed by the candidate;
- 2- A certified true photocopy of birth certificate not older than three months;
- 3- A certified true photocopy of “ Baccalaureate or GCE-A/L certificate or slip for the sciences subjects or equivalent certificate, or the success testimonial of any of these certificates as the case maybe;
- 4- A certified true photocopy of “Probatoire” or GCE O/L certificates or result slips;
- 5- A medical certificate of fitness not older than three months issued by a state medical practitioner;
- 6- An A4 format self-addressed envelope bearing a 1000 francs CFA postal stamp with candidate's address on it.

Article 6: The registration fees for the entrance examination is **Twenty Thousand (20 000) Francs CFA** payable at the **UBA bank Account n° 0 100 500 000 287** of the National Higher Polytechnic School of Douala (NHPSD) of the University of Douala or through the services of **Express Union to the same account in towns where UBA is not present;** (bank receipt should be included in candidates' file). The registration fees are not reimbursable. It is destined to cover charges generated as the result of the organisation of the entrance examination.

Article 7: All complete application files must be deposited at the admissions office of the National Higher Polytechnic School of Douala (NHPSD) of the University of Douala or at the Regional Delegations of the Ministry of Secondary Education no latest than **Thursday 25th July 2024 at 3: 30 pm.**

Article 8: Only candidates who have submitted complete application files will be authorised to sit for the examination. They are therefore requested to come along with their National Identity Card *Infca*

and the examination registration receipt (to be downloaded) which must be presented to the authorities before entering the examination hall.

Article 9: The candidates for the competitive entrance examination into the **first year** must not be more than **twenty-nine (29) years old** by January 1st 2024.

Article 10: The written examination will take place on **Sunday the 28th July 2024, at 8 am** in the centres indicated above.

Article 11: The Rector of the University of Douala, the Director of the Department of University Accreditations and Quality, and the Director of the National Higher Polytechnic School of Douala (NHPSD) of the University of Douala are each in their capacity, responsible for the implementation of this decision which shall be registered and published in English and French wherever need may arise.
